Theosophy as Service

An extract from Living Theosophy: John Algeo

Living Theosophy

To reach liberation enlightenment or salvation – which is health, wholeness, and holiness – three things are needed: study that we may learn, meditation that we may understand and service that we may come to Self Knowledge. We have here another of those great paradoxes of the spiritual life. To serve effectively, we must act out of an understanding that arises from meditating on our study of the great principles. But serving – living to benefit mankind by loving deeds – is the first step, not the third. It is the cause, not the result, of Self Knowledge.

What is Theosophical service? How do we live to benefit mankind? As there are many techniques of meditation, so too there are many avenues of service, and they are all good. But if we try to follow every possible form of meditation we will never understand anything. And if we try to walk every possible path of service, we will never get anywhere.

Theosophy is not just what we know or understand. It is what we do. It is how we live. But we can only do what we know and have made a part of ourselves. Thus living theosophically is a threefold process and a theosophy that is alive is a threefold thing. This requires study, meditation and service: study to discover the truths of the Ancient and Timeless Wisdom, meditation to internalise those truths by making them apart of our inmost nature and service to externalise the truths by applying them in the world around us.

We cannot live a dead theosophy- a Theosophy which exists only in books, which is static and unchanging, which is a museum piece from the 19th century. A Theosophy that is alive must reflect the needs of our time and must apply its timeless truths to those needs. If we are content to repeat the words others have spoken - however exalted those others maybe and however great their words – we do not foster Theosophy as a living growing thing; we

embalm it as an artefact. To live is to grow and change. The oak tree that that grows does



not cease to be an oak tree, the oak tree that does not grow withers and dies. A Theosophy that grows does not cease to be the Ancient Wisdom; a Theosophy that does not grow becomes a historical curiosity.

Service: School of The Wisdom

A heart-warming story from Blavatsky Lodge Member Lucille Ball. Lucile attended this year's School of The Wisdom at Adyar.

A visit was organised for the students of The School of The Wisdom to visit the HPB hostel for boys. The hostel houses and educates from 15-20 boys. These boys are either orphans or from very poor families whose families are unable to provide education. The hostel is situated in the Besant Gardens. The boys are given free board and lodging and they attend the Olcott School. They are also given parental care by the Warden and general guidance in studies and activities. In addition to the academic school program, their daily activities include yoga, meditation, exercise, games, prayer and listening to wholesome stories. The boys also do gardening work around the Hostel building.

During our visit I requested to see the bedrooms to know where/how the boys slept and I was told they slept directly on the floor, also many of the boys had cotton wool in their ears and I asked why? I was told that it was cold at night now in winter and they needed pillows, so when asking if they needed anything else we were informed that yes, they needed mattresses, mats to lay underneath, sheets and covers.

A donation was made from Cornelia Price from the UK who gave a substantial amount but not enough for everything required, so I organised a collection amongst the students of the School of The Wisdom. The donations came mainly from members from Argentina, Finland and Australia.

We were able to reach the target and Maithreya and Sunita of TOS Chennai were able to deliver our gifts just before the School of The Wisdom closed.

I was unfortunately not able to attend the delivery but happy to know everything was done and the boys appeared SO HAPPY!

They are absolutely gorgeous boys, so well educated and respectful and grateful and happy! It was a real pleasure to see those bright eyes and big smiles when little treats were handed to them on our first visit

Reports From Our Local TOS Groups

Sunshine Coast:

Committed TOS worker Joyce Tozer reports that our year began with a healthy bank balance and we were then able to donate \$1500 to various causes. It was distributed as follows \$500 to National TOS towards the SEE project, Tanzanian Heart Babies and Education for women and girls in Pakistan. We also sent \$300 to New Zealand TS towards their Earthquake relief fund, \$300 to Queensland Red Cross following the flood crisis and similarly \$500 between 3 Animal rescue organisations who were dealing with a huge increase in both domestic and native animals in need following the floods.

Other fundraisers were our "Integral Theosophy" seminar which was organised together with the Sunshine Coast Lodge and a successful Garage Sale. Donations of 5-cent pieces amounted to \$385 this year - \$220 of which came from donations by members of a yoga group run by one of our TS members Myra Timmerman.

Not all our energies go into fund raising as we believe that physical service is equally if not more important. To that end some members travelled to Brisbane and distributed sandwiches and fruit to people stranded in cars due to the floods. We also participated in the annual working bee at Springbrook and members cooked at Springbrook for other events during the year. A small group took part in the annual Clean Up Australia' day in March.

One of our TOS members Karen Shakespeare will again travel to the remote village of Mblori in Kenya this year where she has been distributing mosquito nets to combat malaria. Karen travels via Nairobi where she purchases supplies for

the village and this year will meet with Nairobi. TOS Convenor Mrs Usha Sha.
