Welcome to the Village

In a recent newsletter we looked at the three attributes of a loving Father. They were Being there, Unconditional Love and acceptance of how special your child is. In fact these attributes are the attributes of a loving human. We can all strive to achieve this state. The trickiest attribute is Unconditional Love. What is it? It must be more than a feeling because feelings are secret and I know my feelings, but I don't know your feelings. Unconditional Love must be demonstrated through words and actions.

I turned to one of my favourite authors Erich Fromm for help. In 1957 Erich wrote "The Art of Loving". This book is a classic that holds true now, as it was in 1957 and will be in 2057. Erich states love is a skill not a feeling. And like all skills we must practise and learn to master the art.

Erich states all forms of love have four common attributes. The attributes are **Care**, **Responsibility**, **Respect** and **Knowl-edge**.

He defines **Care** as "Love is the active concerns for the life and growth of that which we love".

Responsibility is not a duty but a voluntary act; it is my response to the needs, expressed and unexpressed to another human being. Responsibility could easily deteriorate into domination and possessiveness were it not for Respect.

Respect is the ability to see a person as a unique individual. This means allowing the person to grow and unfold as they wish. Respect means the person is not exploited and used to serve me. Respect is not possible with out knowing the person.

Knowledge is possible when I transcend the concerns for myself and see the other person in their own terms. For instance, a person is angry, if I know them more deeply, I will know that they are anxious, worried, lonely or embarrassed. I will know that they are suffering. When Unconditional Love is considered in these terms it definitely a skill. As with any new skill we need to practise, sometimes getting it right and sometimes getting it wrong. After many years of practise, the skill becomes second nature and we become Masters. Shall we all strive to be Masters of Unconditional Love? I am sure our efforts will bear fruit and improve our own lives and the lives of the people we meet each day.
